



2020 Program Highlights

AROUND THE STATE

Hurricane Relief - More than 1500 animals evacuated and rescued; donated supplies valued at more than a half a million dollars distributed;

Mardi Gras Horse Adoption Program - 20 parade horses saved;



Covid-19 Pet Food Relief - Pet food distributed to animal caregivers, with community giveaways and doorstep deliveries;

Shelter and Rescue Support - Pet food, supplies and equipment distributed to small shelters and rescues;

Emergency Response - More than 150 animals in distress aided in life and death emergencies in rural areas without shelters;

Pet Overpopulation Program - 1500+ animals spayed and neutered;



Cruelty Investigation & Prevention - acted on reports involving 5000+ animals; rescued animals around the state in cases including: 60 dogs bred and neglected in Bossier parish; 13 cats abandoned in Washington parish; 9 dogs (from 30 dog hoarding case in Webster parish) as one of multiple agencies participating; 12 abandoned dogs in Caldwell parish; 3 starving horses in Evangeline parish; 6 cats living in small cages in Vernon parish; 12 neglected dogs in West Carroll parish; 20 neglected cats in St. Helena; 9 dogs abandoned in LaSalle parish and many, many more. Rewards paid in case of 8 rescued puppies thrown from bridge, for return of Stella, beloved dog rescued after car jacking;

Animal Care & Adoption Programs - 1200+ homeless pets transferred from overcrowded shelters to adoption partners; 200 animals provided with daily food and care at our facilities and in foster homes...
