Meanwhile, we worked with Brixx's owner to help publicize the story in the local media, and we pledged a combined reward of \$750 for the dog's safe return. UPDATE: In a very happy update, Brixx has been reunited with his loved ones, almost two months after the crime. He was found rummaging around in a backyard and a young girl recognized Brixx from a news report which covered the story of his abduction. What a happy reunion!
